The Challenge of Adaptation

Adaptation to master. It is all around us and plays a significant role in the entertainment industry. Take the Oscars, for example: screenplays are separated into two categories — Best Original Screenplay and Best Adapted Screenplay. This distinction highlights the prominence of adapted material, which comes in many forms, from subtle references to real-life incidents to entire screenplays based on fictional stories. But do adaptations always succeed with the material they are based on?

A Case Study: Death Note

you're familiar with anime, one classic example is Death Note, a cat-and-mouse game between a detective and a notorious murderer set in Japan. The show features unexpected twists that engross the audience and keep them binge-watching. It was rated 8.9/10 on IMDb.

The movie industry attempted to adapt this show, and in 2022, Netflix released a liveaction Death Note movie, which excited both Netflix viewers and anime fans. Although the acting was commendable, the film failed to capture the allure that made the original Death Note a hit. For instance, the movie strips away the emotional connections between the characters, and the plot's pacing feels rushed.

Reactions to the Adaptation

AS popcorn, and started watching the movie, my mind was filled with critiques within 30 minutes. Adaptation movies should align with the plotlines and character development of the original story, but this film showed little progress over time.

The main character, Light Yagami, was a genius with mind-blowing planning skills that drew many fans into the anime for its thrilling mind games. However, the adaptation's portrayal was the polar opposite of his personality. He was depicted as merely "book smart," which was a letdown due to poor character representation.

It wasn't the concept of adaptation that marked its failure but rather the producers' inability to deliver the true story and characters of the anime. This shortcoming failed to meet our expectations. If I were the director, I would create a live-action TV series, allowing the plotline to flow more naturally. The adaptation might have worked like a charm with its well-balanced pacing and engaging storylines.'

The Rise of Webcomic Adaptations

Webcomics such as manhwa, manga, and comics have become hot topics in recent years. One of the most viewed manhwa, True Beauty, illustrated by Yaongyi, was adapted into a Korean drama in late 2020 and even received an anime adaptation in 2024. With

different forms of adaptation, the storylines changed, as if they were different versions of each other.

Filler episodes and unnecessary side plots left viewers feeling put off, as they expected the same, if not a similar, plotline. Despite the varying narratives, all three adaptations conveyed the same core message that Yaongyi wanted to express — self-love.

Concerns Over Adaptation Quality

As webcomic series since its early publications, the news surrounding the adaptations was a huge shock. The main concern was whether these adaptations could effectively convey the original message of the webcomic, which addresses how teenagers feel pressured to conform to beauty standards.

Adapting to these standards can be more challenging than it seems, and the adaptations made a genuine effort to portray that struggle. However, was it necessary to have multiple adaptations? While the renowned cast brought more attention to the original webcomic, the minor differences in the adaptations' plots often diverted the main message in different directions before reaching a conclusion.

A Success Story: Forrest Gump

Let's surpassed expectations and even outshone its source material: Forrest Gump. Originally published in 1986 by Winston Groom, the bookreceived polarizing reviews. The movie adaptation came eight years later



in 1994. Unlike the book, the film was well-received by critics and audiences alike and remains one of Hollywood's defining movies to this day. So how did this movie outperform its source material?

Preferences: Film vs. Book

Personally, like many others, I preferred the film over the book for several reasons. First, the film and the book took polarizing approaches. The movie used a compelling narrative style, following Forrest's perspective, rather than a linear timeline.

The film adaptation also significantly refined the content of Forrest's adventures, making them both extraordinary and believable. In contrast, the book's adventures often felt oversaturated and exaggerated. For example, in the movie, Forrest joins the army, opens a shrimp company, and becomes a ping-pong champion – all of which feel grounded yet inspiring. The original material, however, Forrest is a WWE boxer and even becomes an astronaut going into space with an orangutan.'

Narrative Depth in Adaptation

my opinion, the book felt like it was exaggerating for the sake of being outrageous in its narrative. Forrest's tales came across as fictional and impossible. The film, on the other hand, dramatically changed that narrative, providing more grounded and emotionally compelling stories. Although the film may not have been a faithful adaptation, those creative liberties were likely for the best.

Conclusion: The Dual Nature of Adaptation

is a double-edged sword: it can lead to either disappointment or remarkable success. When done right, it enhances the original material and elevates it to new heights. Ultimately, it's up to the screenwriter to pull the strings and breathe life into the story.

Adapting a story to appease both fans and new audiences is a challenging feat, but with the right tools and direction, success is within reach!

I've also learned to make clear and concise notes using the Cornell Notes system. Most importantly, remember not to burn yourself out; you'll be mentally and physically exhausted after a short period. I recommend picking up a hobby or something you're passionate about to help maintain a balance between your studies and personal life.

I want to echo the importance of balance but focus on the role of subject selection in making Form 4 manageable. Choosing subjects you enjoy encourages you not to give up when you encounter obstacles and allows you to push past your limits and perform better.

I chose Geography, a subject I love. Many topics in Geography require memorization, including various landforms such as volcanic island arcs and faulting. Tests and exams will be challenging; the questions are different from what you experienced in your earlier years at TTCA. You'll need to write essays about measures to combat natural hazards, and the marking system is very strict. However, my passion for Geography helped me push through these challenges, allowing me to achieve high marks on every test.

Abby Lee

I would like to shift the focus to an oftenoverlooked aspect of Form 4: book reports. Book reports were something I never expected to fret over when asked about my worries in Form 3. I found myself racing against time, struggling to balance reading and studying simultaneously. It's a wonder I managed to hand in my analyses on schedule.

Luckily, I'm giving you all a heads-up: make

good use of your reading time. Flip through some novels—perhaps some dystopian books like The Hunger Games or Fahrenheit 451, or maybe you prefer the classics, such as Pride and Prejudice or To Kill a Mockingbird. I want to share my experience with the increased depth and complexity of Form 4 Science. Personally, the jump from Form 3 Science to Form 4 Science was significantly more challenging. I was overwhelmed with the sheer amount of information in each chapter and the technical jargon.

My advice is to conduct extra research on topics you don't understand – don't ignore

them, hoping they'll eventually make sense. That tiny seed of confusion can grow into an obstacle, leading to frustration or, worse, falling behind. Be a proactive learner. Address any problems or information gaps immediately, whether through extra revision or watching educational videos on YouTube. Develop a habit of studying ahead of time, and don't hesitate to ask your teachers whenever you're confused!

From Amateur to Dro: My Diano Journey of Growth

 often described as one Piano of the easiest instruments to learn — was my passion, yet I treated it like a mere showcase for my skills (which, to be honest, were far from impressive).

I have always had a deep love for classical music; pop music never fulfilled me, as it felt overly repetitive and lacked the complexity I craved. I longed for something grand and challenging — pieces difficult enough to impress my friends and family. Classical music fit the bill perfectly. After seven years of lackluster piano lessons marred by my laziness, I finally decided to take my practice seriously. Everything changed when a friend I met at the HKU Info Day suggested I seek professional piano lessons. Despite arrogance about my abilities, I was intrigued by this "professional" teacher. On January 1st, my trial lesson with him began.

The Awakening

in my skills, I played Confident the famous coda of Chopin's Ballade op. 23. After my "performance," the response was blunt: "Let's start at the beginning." What followed felt like a roast session. He wasn't impressed and didn't think I was ready to be his student, so he referred me to another teacher.

This teacher, while still strict, was kinder. Thus began my transformation from an amateur show-off to a dedicated pianist who genuinely

cared about more than just flaunting my skills. Transitioning from casual lessons to professional training was no easy feat.

The Struggle

vividly remember my first month: I was Loonstantly scolded for not counting my time. My teacher banned me from using the metronome and insisted I count aloud at any tempo to avoid rushing. But being the lazy person I was, I slacked off during practice, naively thinking she wouldn't notice. I was sorely mistaken.

Each week, I was reprimanded for not practicing effectively. She demanded I count out loud and practise slowly, even for sections I thought I could already play fluently. She emphasised deliberate, controlled playing, leaving no room for rushing. As a young and immature student, I struggled to meet her expectations and faced the consequences at every lesson.

Despite my shortcomings, she remained committed to my improvement. She never slacked during our lessons, answering even my simplest questions with detailed recordings that ranged from 10 seconds to over a minute. Even while traveling across Germany for her own commitments (we had online lessons), she made time to listen to my recordings. Her dedication made me feel guilty for my lack of effort.

The Turning Point

That I resolved to abandon my lazy attitude and embrace the discipline required for growth. During the summer, I practised 3-5 hours every day and studied piano at night.

My friend once advised me against practising too much over the holidays, but I ignored the suggestion. I was determined to change and adapt to the world of professionals, where excuses didn't exist, and everyone gave their all to achieve both technical mastery and musicality. The journey was steep, and I could feel the allure of games and television, beckoning me to relax, but I pressed on.

The Transformation

while I still see myself as an now, amateur pianist, I've moved beyond my old habits of rushing through pieces and skipping details. I can now count my time properly and pinpoint areas for improvement.

Adapting isn't about letting the environment change you; it's about your willingness to change and fit into the environment – or persist in your ways while ignoring the world around you. Adapting to new challenges requires perseverance and determination. One cannot rise to higher standards by turning a blind eye to the obstacles ahead.

Final Thoughts

there's one message I hope to deliver to TTCiAns, it's this: constantly strive to improve yourself and adapt to any challenges life throws your way. 記 者:對於此計畫的實施,學生的表現如何?

陳淑敏老師:經過兩個月的實行,學生的表現漸見 進步。在師長積極監察下,學生基本上 願意合作,做得到亦做得好。但在非積 極監察時段,例如午膳時間中後段,學 生的參與度及成效普遍略為降低。

林學春老師:目前的廚餘主要為飯類或麪類,但這 類廚餘水份太多,分解出來的物質營養 價值較低。而且,現時廚餘機的容量未 能處理所有廚餘。所以,學生取用合適 份量的食物,減少廚餘至關重要。

記 者: 您對於學生如今的環保意識有何看 法,有什麼可以改進的地方嗎?

林學香老師: 計劃實施後, 學生回收意識有所提升, 也更關注環保議題, 但距離有效實踐 綠色生活, 仍需有更大的變化。

陳淑敏老師:在提供足夠設施的情況下,校園垃圾分類的政策運作良好,相信有效提升了全校師生的環保意識。部分參與回收的同學及班主任也做得很好,態度積極正面。唯獨在紙包飲品的處理上未如理想,例如部份丟棄品中尚餘大量飲料未有倒出,吸引蚊蟲。此外,亦有同學未有認真尊重及考慮回收組的感受,曾有同學將尚餘半杯的珍珠奶茶投放在紙盒收集筒中,導致他人要在數日後處理已變質的奶茶。

就新政策而言,我們也訪問了校工的看法。我們收集了7位校工的意見,請他們為以下項目進行評分,5分為最認同,1分為最不認同。

針對新政策令校園更整潔的觀點,有6位校工給予了5分,1位校工給予了3分。

針對新政策可令校工的工作量減輕,有6位校工給 予了3分,1位校工給予了2分。

透過這次訪問,我們不難發現,雖然部分學生在適應新政策的過程中遇到困難,但大多數學生對垃圾和廚餘分類的環保意義表示理解與支持。隨著學校不斷加強宣傳和指導,相信越來越多學生能夠熟悉並習慣這個制度。同時,老師和校工也對政策的執行效果持正面態度,尤其是對環保意識的提升。然而,在操作的細節上則仍有改善空間,例如加強紙包飲品的回收管理、優化時間安排等。

展望未來,在各方的共同努力下,這項政策將為學校帶來更大的環保成效,並進一步提升師生的環保素養。讓我們攜手並肩,從每一個小舉措開始,共同書寫屬於我們的校園綠色篇章。

2022年,生成式大型自然語 標型ChatGPT橫空出世,揭 了人類歷史上新一代人工智能的 唯幕。時至2024年,人工智能的 發展如日中天,已成為全是的的 的焦點。不難預視,這將自己 的大趣勢,對個人應用以至 來職正發展有百利而無一害。



人工智能的技術不似傳統程式編寫般單一,是一個涵蓋機器學習、自然語言處理、計算機 視覺等多個領域的綜合體系。隨着人工智能的技術發展越趨複雜成熟,作為使用者,我們毋須 理解背後的算法或學習過程,只須掌握其特性與優缺點,便可有效利用這些工具,協助我們達 成使用目的。


目前,人工智能重大局限之一在於缺乏創造力。人工智能依賴背後龐大的數據庫,透過對數據庫的「學習」,人工智能可在某程度上模擬人類的創意過程,然而卻終究無法實現真正的創新。可見,作為人類使用者,我們的真正優勢在於獨有而無窮的創造力。因此,個人獨立思維與創意絕對是我們應珍而重之的能力。一旦掌握了天馬行空的本領,並將意念轉化成人工智能可準確理解的指令(Prompt),我們的創意便不再是虛無縹緲的幻想,而是能在人工智能的助力下得以實現的奇思妙想。

然而,人工智能的應用不再遙不可及,我們需要保持警醒,留意衍生的各種問題。我們日常瀏覽的社交媒體、串流平台以及搜尋引擎等,都是根據用戶行爲及使用習慣訓練的演算法。這些演算法通過收集及分析用戶感興趣的主題,繼而推薦相關內容,以達成平台自身或廣告客戶的商業目的。演算法提供的便利讓用戶不知不覺上癮,在瀏覽過程中接觸大量與自己觀點相符的內容。潛移默化下,我們會對自己的原有觀點更為堅信不移,並建立起牢固而局限的舒適圈。長此以往,我們的視野將變得狹隘,思維會受網絡平台的「圍爐」風氣侵蝕而日漸單一。

因此,為避免思維在智能演算法下變得遲鈍、麻木,批判思考乃每一位網絡原居民不可或缺的能力。

在保持警醒的同時,我們也要持續關注人工智能的最新發展。近年,人工智能工具爆炸性成長,種類更越趨多樣,範疇涵括文字、程式碼、圖像、影片、動畫、音樂、簡報、網站等。使用者應多測試各種工具和模型,或參考專業人士的測評,以了解各項工具的特性與限制,從中選擇最切合自己需要的產品。使用過程中,亦宜多與同儕交流,切忌在一日千里的科技洪流中閉門造車,才可發揮人工智能工具的最大價值。



Cyberstalking? Don't get cooked!

Pay attention to cyberstalking... or you'll live to regret it! might be wondering, what exactly is cyberstalking? According to trustworthy sources,

You cyberstalking occurs when a cybercriminal uses email, direct messaging, or other online methods to harass, intimidate, or threaten someone with physical harm. This can include tracking someone's online activity, spreading rumors, or even creating fake profiles to manipulate or deceive victims. For example, cyberstalkers may pose as your friends on social media platforms to gain access to your location. So, why is it important to learn about cyberstalking? Because it often goes hand in hand with offline stalking and can escalate to physical danger, making it extremely harmful!


Numbers don't lie!

Reliable sources indicate that the threat of cyberstalking is growing worse. Research shows that as children grow older, their likelihood of experiencing cyberbullying increases. In 2020, 7.5 million people were affected, and by 2021, this number rose to 7.7 million—a significant

jump. Today, 15% of stalking victims are aged 10 to 18. The rise of new platforms, such as Snapchat, may have contributed to this trend. While starting a Snap streak might seem fun, users should be cautious about sharing their location. It's best to turn off location sharing or limit it to trusted friends rather than making it public.

Don't fall into the "mousetrap"!

In 2016, a 12-year-old student was cyberstalked by an older man after publicly sharing personal



information online. This led to the teen's information being doxed, and soon after, he began receiving strange and harassing phone calls from an unknown number. Initially, the teen ignored the calls, but the situation escalated when he was kidnapped! The cyberstalker demanded a large sum of money from his parents, causing financial strain and leaving the teenager mentally scarred. This serves as a stark reminder: if you receive suspicious calls, block the number immediately and stay vigilant!

Brace yourself!


how can you protect yourself from cyberstalking? Here are four simple and secure steps to help **So**, you stay safe:

- 1. Use strong passwords for your social media accounts and change them regularly.
- 2. Be cautious of suspicious links in messages or on online platforms.


Ms. Chan Hiu Lam
