My Experience from

Colourful Food Workshop



Colour is an important aspect in our enjoyment of food. The objective of this workshop is to guide students to research on the chemicals embedded in food and beverages that are responsible for the colours. Through the understanding of a variety of molecular structures, chemical separations and analyses of some colourants, students can get a taste of modern scientific research.

I have recently joined a workshop organized by Junior Science Institute, the University of Hong Kong. The workshop let student participants experience different kinds of science experiments in Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics and Earth Science.

"Colourful food" was a program about Chemistry. From the lesson, I learnt about natural and artificial pigments in food with different molecular shapes and structures. Also, I found that the chemical properties of different food pigments are different. Artificial food pigments contain charge, but natural food pigments mostly do not. They are both very soluble in water.

The most unforgettable and enjoyable thing I did in the workshop was to do experiments. We extracted pigments from vegetables, candies and drinks. For example, I extracted pigments from red cabbage as a pH indicator to test the pH value of all substances at homelike using, pigments from m & m chocolate to do the Thin-layer Chromatography(TLC) to identify dye used in it, as well as a pigment from a tomato called lycopene, which make tomatoes look reddish-orange. Besides these, I used spectroscopic method to identify the concentration of tartrazine (a yellow artificial pigment) in a drink.

I highly recommend my friends to attend similar programs next time, because we can gain more science knowledge about our daily lives apart from textbooks.



I love photography. To be precise, I love to capture interesting moments







我因兩種信念而與眾不同 3A 柯卓康

親愛的柯卓康同學:

前幾天我在辦公室裏收到你寄來的信。可惜我還有許多學生的論文 需要檢閱,直到今天才能抽空讀信。我為此真的感到抱歉,希望你能體

你所提出的問題可真有意思。雖然我不太認為自己就是你所描述的 「科學臣早」、「最偉大的天才」,但你說我與眾不同這我又倒是認同 的。當初提出相對論後,人們認為我徹底瘋了。但理論經證實後,他們 又讚揚其至鼓吹我為「科學巨人」。但從頭到尾我不是其麼「瘋子」, 更不是其麼「科學巨人」。我只不過是思維與信念與他人有點不一樣而 已。你想知道為何我是與眾不同的科學家嗎?那便先讓我跟你說我研究 相對論的故事吧!

在我發表相對論前,人們都堅信光是由一種叫「乙太」的介質傳播 的, 益相信存在它的絕對參照系。當大家視這條定律為神聖不可侵犯的 時候,隨後的「邁克耳孫—莫雷實驗」便向他們潑了一盆冷水;乙太 被證實是不存在的!全世界的科學家都開始慌張起來了,並試圖在乙太 存在的條件下解釋實驗結果。但我很早心前已提出了自己對乙太的強烈 質疑,並指出了當中的矛盾之處。但教授們對我的想法只是冷嘲動調罷 了。當時人們認為物理學的架構已經大政上完成了,已經不需要其麼發 展,所以他們才視我的研究為多餘益不切實際的。但我並沒有理會他 們。從大學畢業到在瑞士專利局工作,我也一直埋頭思考著這個問題。 直至實驗結果公佈並引起激烈討論後,我便提出了這兩項假設:第一, **劣速對於任何慣性參照系都是一樣的,絕對不受其他因素影響。所以乙** 太的存在县没有意義的。第二,物理定律對任何參照系都县相對但相同 的,而時間及空間對於不同參照系的運動都有所不同,所以絕對性的參 照系、運動、時間都不存在。基於這些大膽的假設,我於一九一五年發 表了《論動體的雷動動學》一文。嗯,就是你所說的其麼「技驚四產」 、「翻天覆地」、「革命性的」及「改變世人的科學觀」的相對論。(這又太誇張了吧!)

跟你說了那麼多,究竟我想分享的訊息是其麼呢?不是跟你炫耀我 有多棒,而是表達我在研究時所持守的信念。第一,不要把一切都看得 理所當然。孩子,永遠不要放下孩童的好奇心。哪怕你身邊的家人朋 友、同學師長都對你的表現感到莫名其妙,你還是要繼續發問,繼續發 掘更多問題。因為提出一個問題永遠比解決一個問題重要。新的問題表



徵著更多的可能性,也是通径一個未知領域的大門。為其麼蘋果會掉下來 呢?砰!萬有引力理論誕生了!當人跑得像光速一樣快速時會怎樣呢?砰! 相對論誕生了!我在前面說過,人們覺得我這些問題有點荒唐,對吧?正是 這些苦唐的問題改變了整個科學史。相對論的作用在於它重新審視了時間、 空間、運動等物理概念、挑戰了舊有的觀念、並以全新的觀點探討他們。此 墨我故意把乙太的存在視作理所當然,相對論就不會出現了。聽著,孩子, 要抱著好奇心及質疑的態度學習:挑戰自己的認知,打破自己舊南的觀念, 忘記自己所知的一切,以今新的眼光去探索這個世界。在這個過程中,你便 可以創造或發現新的事物,可能更是超平你所想像的。這些經驗就是如此把 我塑造成與眾不同的科學家。

第二,要懂得選其道而行。與眾不同的人就是看見那些人們所看不見 的,想到別人所棍不到的,崔能做到其他人所不敢做的。他們不在意人們的 看信,並不跟隨世界的主流思想與文化。剛好相反,他們喜歡把現實反轉, **益發掘不同的新主意。我不否認自己就是那麼「叛逆」的人。那時人們小** 心翼翼的硬是用那煩人的乙太來解釋光速運動,我便乾脆不用乙太直接設定 劣速的不變性; 那時人們堅信時間與空間是相互獨立的,我乾脆把兩者拼起 來,形成四維時空來描述運動。這不是在故意唱反調,而是當我們以相反的 角度思考時,往往能發掘許多前所去有的創新成果。但最重要的是,遂其道 而行需要相當大的勇氣。在你的想法成真前,你會遭到世人許多無情的批評 及嘲諷。他們想藉由打擊你來摧毀你的信心,從而封阻你通往成功的道路。 我們不用理會他們的動機,只要瞭得這類的人在世上多的是。我在發表相對 論後便遭到排山倒海的批評攻擊。不管是科學家、哲學家其至政治家(針對 我是猶太人的身份)都透過公開演講及發表文章來抨擊相對論,意圖向世人 說明相對論的理念根本是苦謬的。你問我在發表前有沒有預料到這些事?有 的。但我沒因此打算放棄。創新的成果是需要付出代價的。對創新者來說 **逆道而行县需要勇氮的,他人的青鞜县通往成功的必經之路。但若能夠抵受** 世人的攻擊,而且做出別人不敢做也不敢想像的事,才是讓我們與眾不同的 原因。我最終推過去了。孩子,你可以嗎?

堅守這兩個信念是十分困難的,但就是凡事質疑的態度及遜道而行的精 神成就了我的不平凡,也成就了歷史上許多偉人的不平凡。孩子,謹記我的 話,在堅信自己能夠成就創新的去來。因為正是那些瘋得心為自己能改變世 界的人,才能真正改變世界。


領犬義工體驗日


